4. Accounts payable and accruals

Accounts payable and accruals includes payroll remittances due to government for monthly payroll deductions of \$1,058 (2023 - \$1,070) and PST remittances of \$219 (2023 - \$99).

Accounts payable and accruals also includes \$8,199 (2023 - \$8,199) which represents monies received from Bowl Canada for the equalization of travel costs related to the Youth Bowling Canada events. This amount belongs to the Association and when the equalization program is terminated, any remaining amount will be recorded as revenues or expenses.

5. Advances from activity participants

These advances represent unspent resources internally restricted and related to activities of various bowling programs administered by the Association and occurring in the subsequent period.
